





You checked the thermometer and it's a warm day. Go forward 2 spaces.

You have a week of warm and sunny weather. Go forward 5 spaces.




Everyone walked to school this week and the air became cleaner for your bulb! Go forward 6 spaces.




Yay, it's snowing! But your bulb got very cold... Go back 2 spaces.

It was so hot this week that your bulb got too dry. Go back 4 spaces.




A hungry rabbit came and nibbled on the shoot growing from your bulb! Go back 5 spaces.




Oh no, someone carelessly trampled all over your garden! Go back 6 spaces.


When printing these cards, check "print on both sides of the paper" and "flip on short edge".

Cut out the cards and shuffle before playing the game!









Some fallen leaves have decomposed in your pot and improved the soil. Go forward 3 spaces.




A friendly spider made its web near your pot and ate all the pests! Go forward 4 spaces.





The class worked hard to pick up litter and tidy up the school garden. Go forward 5 spaces.
