At the end of a grant scheme, Edina prepares a report to the Local Authority to describe the impact of its funding on the teaching and learning of science in schools. It uses evidence gathered from schools' reports to demonstrate its impact, as in the example below:

Primary School received all three grants, and a nursery grant, and described the impact of Edina's funding as transformative: "Before the Edina Grants, I audited the Science resources. Many had not been used for a long time, and were out of date or unusable. After the Edina grants, we now have an extensive Science resources cupboard, and whole class experiments are happening regularly around school. Science now has the 'wow' factor again in my school."
